(Eph.5:8-14)

#### INTRODUCTION:

One stormy night, a group of fishermen were desperately fighting for their lives on the raging and agitated stormy sea. They were out in the pitch black night with none to guide them to the direction of the shore. Suddenly in the utter darkness, a burst of light erupted from the distant shore. Knowing their position, they frantically rowed with all their might to where the light shone. They were saved on account of the burning shade house which was intentionally burned by one of the wives, to guide the fisher folks safely home!

#### ERSTWHILE UNDESIRABLE LIVING WITHOUT LIGHT

1.The past in darkness walk	- "For you were once in darkness,"	Eph.5:8
2. The present contrasting walk	- "But now"	Eph.5:8
3. The desirable walk	- "you are in the light"	Eph.5:8
