Proposed hiring of evangelist for Bokod for approval today

As earlier announced, the TUESDAY CHURCH FORUM is recommending to the congregation the proposal of the MISSION OUTREACH MINISTRY (MOM), that a fulltime evangelist—minister would be employed in evangelism and in serving the spiritual needs of the Bokod congregations, namely, Poblacion, Pito, and Penged. This came about with the observation that the Bokod congregations have significantly weakened because of the lack of a full-time evangelist in the area. Occasional visits by the MOM and other volunteers also proved inadequate to edify or strengthen said congregations.

In line with this, MOM recommends employing brother James Biadno, Filipino, single, of legal age, and a fresh graduate of the ASIAN CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY (ACU), as full-time evangelist-minister. He is also known to the brethren and the community.

As the Bokod congregations are incapable of financially supporting him at the moment, MOM recommends that his wages for at least one year will be raised by way of special collections or pledges from Midtown brethren. It was recommended that a monthly basic pay of P8000.00 and a monthly Representation and Transportation Allowance (RATA) of P2000.00 be allotted for him.

Today, the Midtown congregation will be asked to ratify the said recommendation after a brief appeal and presentation by brother Gregory C. Kitma, representative of the MOM. Ω
