

LESSONS FROM THE LIFE OF JACOB

<Gen.25:20-34; Gen.27:35,36>

INTRODUCTION:

Jacob, means a supplanter: Gen.27:36, born about B.C.1836, near the well Lahai-roi. Jacob cheated Esau, his elder brother of his birthright by unscrupulous means: Gen.25:33. Jacob also robbed Esau of his patriarchal blessing: Gen.27:36, with the machination of Rebekah Gen.27:10, causing Jacob to escape the vengeful wrath of Esau: Gen.27:43. During his return from Haran twenty years after, his name was changed to Israel: Gen.32;28, which literally means God's soldier. <Smith's Dictionary of the Bible, p.140>

1. Late marriage of Isaac	- "Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife,"	Gen.25:20
