

hen Jehu was born, he hit the dirt hen Jenu was born, he hit the dirt running. King Jehu became a byword for recklessness and aggression. His dynasty has been called by the experts the *"Execution Dynasty,"* since they killed kings about like you'd flick flies off the kitchen table. Read his biography for yourself, you'll see (2Kings 9:11–10:36). Jehu drove a wild chariot and spent more time raiging dust in the two-wheel wonder than he

raising dust in the two—wheel wonder than he did raising money on the throne. In fact, his entire reputation revolved around his driving. On one occasion he sealed a friendship by a maddening chariot ride, during which he demonstrated his "zeal for the Lord" (2Kings 10:15-16). Earlier in 2 Kings 9:20, we can see that the national byword for "*fast and furious*" driving was "*driving like the driving of Jehu*." Sons and daughters of Jehu live on. Polished cedar chariots pulled by lathered-up stallions cedar chariots pulled by lathered-up stallions have changed into a sleek, slick, four-on-the-

floor job or a neat little sports car or a handsome sedan. But there's an amazing similarity between the drivers and their reputations. It is said that for drivers, God's work of grace moves downward—from head to feet—and the last part of them to experience full salvation is their *right foot*, the one on the gas / accelerator—the one most engaged in selfishness on the road. So, they say, the way we act behind the wheel is far more indicative of our walk with God than the way we act praying in a pew or smiling over a well-marked Bible.

Well, why don't you and I commit ourselves to a little less speed and (unlike Jehu) a lot less "furious" reputation. Honestly ask some, "How's my driving?" And if we occasionally must speed up, maybe it would help to sing loudly:


- At 45mph... "God Will Take Care of You" At 55 mph..."Guide Me,O Thou Great Jehovah"
- At 65 mph... "Nearer My God To Thee" At 75 mph... "Nearer, Still Nearer" At 85 mph... "This World Is Not My Home" At 95 mph... "Lord, I'm Coming Home"
- Over 100 ... "Precious Memories"
