Focusing on the specified purpose of the prayer we are leading should guide us as to what to mention in the prayer. For example, if the Lord's Supper, then things to be mentioned in that prayer should be centered on that. Don't mention about the cup, about the speaker, about the sermon, about politics, and other matters here. Be direct to the point. **1. OPENING PRAYER OR INVOCATION.** To invoke the Allmighty God to cause the congregation to set our

To mention the book, chapter or verse in the Bible is not necessary. God knows that for it originated from Him. H. PRAYERS BETTER IF SPOKEN IN AUDIBLE VOICE

TO BE HEARD BY ALL. As much as possible, since prayer leaders are directing the whole congregation in prayer, he should speak loud enough for everyone in the congregation to hear him and be able to say "AMEN" to the prayer uttered. Mind the use of the microphone.

I. PRAYERS BETTER IF NOT SPOKEN TOO FAST TO BE UNDERSTOOD. Since it is our intention to lead the congregation in prayer, it is important to always keep in mind that our prayers are to be well understood by the congregation such that there will be no impediment or hindrance in saying AMEN to it. PRIVATE AND PERSONAL REQUESTS BETTER AVOIDED IN PUBLIC PRAYERS. For public prayers, it AVOIDED IN PUBLIC PRAYERS. For public prayers, it does not refer to a place. So, better to say "as we leave this place or hall of worship" when referring to a place where the church is gathered (Eph1:22,23; 1Cor12:27); *"For this bread that will nourish us"* Referring to the bread as symbol of the body of Christ at the Lord's Super, its purpose is not to nourish our bodies but to remind us of Christ's sacrifice; "As we offer our tithes" Tithing or 10% giving is an Old Testament practice for the Israelites only.
