A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE BEGINNINGS OF THE MIDTOWN CHURCH OF CHRIST

The MIDTOWN CHURCH OF CHRIST, a local church faithful to the pattern of the New Testament church of Christ in the first century (33 AD), began on October 16, 1983 when a handful of faithful Christian families from the Baguio Church of Christ, faithful Christian families from the Baguio Church of Christ, namely, families of Felix A. Bravo, Santiago B. Sameon II, Simeon S. Reyes, Daniel A. Oliva, Paulino Abubo and some students of the Philippine Bible College commenced a new work of preaching the pure gospel at the heart of the city and started a Worship Assembly at the Conference Hall of the YMCA Bldg., Upper Session Road, Baguio City.

After a year, the congregation moved to the 3rd Floor of the Puso Ng Baguio Building, Session Road, at the time when brother David Allen Stathopulo, a missionary sponsored by the Saturn Road Church of Christ, Mesquite, Texas, USA, joined the work at Midtown and started the RIBLE STIJDY CENTER

the work at Midtown and started the BIBLE STUDY CENTER. Bible teachers then helping in said center were Ruth L. Glori, Janice Reyes, Felix Bravo, Danny Oliva, Santiago Sameon II, spouses David and Sandy Stathopulo, and spouses Simeon Jr. and Phoebe Reyes. Later, two American missionary Jr. and Phoebe Reyes. Later, two American missionary couples came to help in the work, namely, spouses Eddie and Sherry Poblete and spouses Doug and Sandy Holcomb. Sisters Janice Reyes and Jeanette Fetalino served as secretaries for the Bible Study Center on Session Road, while sisters Vickie Hombrebueno and Rose Macion served as secretaries of the Bible Study Center opened by brother Eddie Poblete at the 3rd Floor, GP Building, Upper Mabini Street. Between 1983 and 1984, thirty-four people were baptized. In 1985, more than a hundred people have been baptized into Christ. Later, the congregation has employed full-time staff evangelists and ministers, namely, brothers Arnan A. Bayla (1987), Felix L. Olidan Jr. (1988), and Andres E. Bestre (1994). As the congregation grew numerically, more space was needed which made the congregation rent one place to another. The first move was to the 3rd Floor of the Maharlika was needed which made the congregation refit one place to another. The first move was to the 3rd Floor of the Maharlika Livelihood Center (1985). Then to the Baguio Patriotic High School gymnasium (1987), then to the University of Baguio Little Theater or Dap-ayan (1987), UB Education Building (1988), Baguio-Benguet Community Credit Cooperative Conference Hall (1990), and to the Bible Study Center centred by brother Setters. conference Hall (1990), and to the Bible Study Center opened by brother Sotero B. Denis at the 3rd Floor, Dangwa Terminal Building (1991). Having rented two office units at the Puso Ng Baguio Building along Session Road, the congregation once more conducted her worship assemblies there until 1993. Owing to the high rate of rentals after the 1990 killer earthquake, the church welcomed the offer of the Bayatings for Midtown to hold office and to conduct its worship recombined to the conduction of the Bayatings for Midtown to hold office and to conduct its worship recombined to the conduction of the study of the Market's possible of the study of the Market's possible property. assemblies at the 5th Basement Floor of the Marlett's Building located on Km. 4 Marcos Highway in 1993 for free. In 1995, the congregation transferred to the Top Floor of the same building free of charge and which is currently the congregation's office and assembly place.
