**GUIDELINES FOR THE 2017 PASASALAMAT**

- 5. If coming from downtown Baguio, free PUJ transportation will also be provided from BDO Legarda (near City Hall) to take you to Riverview at exactly 8 AM. If you take this option, you are expected to take the same jeepney to transport you back to town. The same will leave Riverview at 3:30 PM. PLEASE SIGN UP NOT LATER THAN DECEMBER 10. 2017 IF YOU WILL TAKE THIS OPTION. Please find the SIGN UP sheets on one of the bulletin boards.
- 6. Once at the venue, kindly follow the directions of the designated ushers/usherettes.
- 7. Lunch will be served through controlled buffet by the catering service authorized personnel only.
