Heavens and earth creation Gen.2:4 2. Uses of daytime of creation - "in the day that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens". Gen.2:4 .<Uses of the term "Day": Jn.11:9; 12 hours daylight; 24 hours of daylight and darkness, Gen.1:5; 6 days of daylight and darkness creation, Gen.24; 40 years day of wandering- Heb.3:8,9; 1,000 years, day; Any day response to appeal of salvation: 2 Cor.6:2.> 3. Prior plant and herb - "before any plant of the field was in the earth and before any herb of the field had grown. For the Gen.2:5 Lord God had not caused it to rain on the earth, and there was no man to till the ground." 4. Evaporation - "but a mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground." Gen.2:6 5. Making of man - And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the Gen.2:7 breath of life: and man became a living being." Abode of man provided by God - "The Lord God planted a garden eastward in Eden, and there he put man whom he had Gen.2:8 formed." -"And out of the ground the Lord God made very tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and good Gen.2:9 2. Good and unpleasant trees for food. The tree of life was also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good made and evil." Gen.2:11 where there is gold." 3.Gihon, name of the second river - it is the one that encompasses the whole land of Cush. Gen.2:13 4.Hiddekel/Tigris third river: - "The name of the third river is Hiddekel: it is the one which goes toward the east of Assyria. Euphrates, fourth river The fourth river is the Euphrates." Gen.2:14 GOD PLACED MAN IN THE GARDEN WITH RESPONSIBILITIES AND CHARGES 1. Man with responsibility to do - "Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.." Gen.2:15 2. Charged to freely eat Gen.2:16 - "And the Lord God commanded man saying, 'Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat;..." 3. Charge, not to eat - "But of the tree of knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it Gen.2:17 vou shall surely die." GOD MADE THE WOMAN AND CHARGED MAN IN THE NAMING OF: BEASTS, BIRDS AND CREATURES 1. No helper companion for man - "And the Lord said. 'It is not good that man should be alone: I will make him a helper Gen.2:18 comparable to him." 2. Making of beast, bird and - "Out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and Gen.2:19 brought them Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creatures creature, that was its name.' 3.Naming of every creature - "So Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. Burt Gen.2:20 for Adam there was not found a helper comparable to him." GOD'S PROCEDURE IN MAKING WOMAN, AND THE BEGINNING OF MARRIAGE 1.
