

# serving even if retired at sixty-six

Brother ANDRES EMPIZO BESTRE, also known as "Brother Andy" has recently retired legally effective January 31, 2021. The CHURCH FORUM meeting every Tuesday at the MIDTOWN ASSEMBLY HALL has granted his retirement in behalf of the congregation which he served for twenty-seven years now. He started working for the congregation as CHURCH SECRETARY in April, 1994 and then as EVANGELIST since January, 1996. He was also the ACTING LIAISON OFFICER of the congregation as an official representative to government agencies such as the SEC, BIR, PHILHEALTH, PAG-IBIG, BENECO, BWD, and others. He long served as chairman of the ÉDIFICATION MINISTRY.

As per regulations of the DEPARTMENT OF LABOR & EMPLOYMENT (DOLE), an employee reaching the age of sixty-five shall be retired and shall receive corresponding retirement benefits. Thus, as per DOLE GUIDELINES ON RETIREMENT, brother Andy Bestre shall receive the amount of THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND AND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (PHP366,750.00) as RETIREMENT PAY from the MIDTOWN CHURCH OF CHRIST. Said amount will be given him in two installments—fifty percent (50%) to be given him in January, 2021 and the other fifty (50%) will be given to him in July, 2021. However, brother Andy Bestre and the TUESDAY

CHURCH FORUM agreed that he shall continue to discharge his usual function on a contractual (yearly) basis subject to renewal upon mutual agreement of both parties. This arrangement will also give enough time for a smooth transition period to take place and for him to train and turn over his duties to whoever will be employed by the MIDTOWN CHURCH OF CHRIST to take over his function.

Meanwhile, it was also agreed that he will be remunerated as usual except for the Employer's share for contributions in SSS, PHILHEALTH, AND PAG-IBIG during the period of his contractual employment with Midtown.

A copy of the MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) between the MIDTOWN CHURCH OF CHRIST and brother Andy Bestre is printed on Page 2 of this bulletin for the congregation's perusal. $\Omega$

The MIDTOWN CHURCH OF CHRIST with office address at Top Floor. Marlett's Building, Km. 4 Marcos Highway, Baguio City, herein represented by the President of the Board of Trustees, BRO. ERNESTO B. WAGANG, called the FIRST PARTY;

BRO. ANDRES E. BESTRE, of legal age, married, Filipino Citizen, with residence at No. 290 Purok VI, Upper Quezon Hill, Baguio City, called the SECOND PARTY.

#### WITNESSETH:

That the FIRST PARTY has granted the retirement of the SECOND PARTY effective January 31, 2021 so he could avail of his retirement benefits pursuant to the Labor Code. However, he shall continue to discharge his function as an Evangelist and other work assignments to the FIRST PARTY but on a contractual basis until the FIRST PARTY hires a replacement for the good of the service.

That this contract is good for one (1) year subject to renewal upon mutual agreement of both parties.

That the FIRST PARTY shall continue to remunerate the SECOND PARTY of his salaries and other benefits except for Employer's share for contributions in SSS, PHILHEALTH, and PAG-IBIG during the period of this contract.

That this contract is being executed for the mutual benefit of both parties.
