5. Observe physical distancing. Be at a safe distance from one another at least one (1) meter radius apart.
6. No handshakes, hugs, kisses, fist bumps, or any physical contact. Greet one another verbally, bowing to each other, or waiving hands to each other. waiving hands to each other.
7. Observe safe foot traffic at the stairways. Give way to

8. Every person must step on the SANITIZING FOOTBATH MAT before entry.

9. Every person must bring his or her own BALLPEN to fill in the LOGBOOK before entry.
