Brethren we learned from our study about:

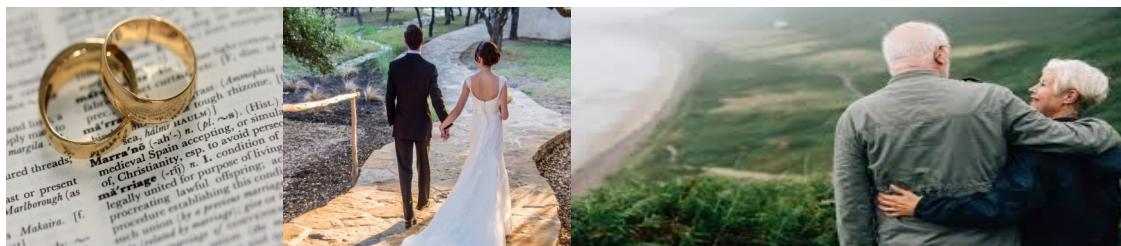
#### Admonishment for Wives

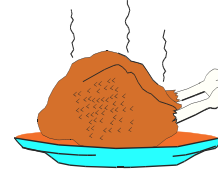
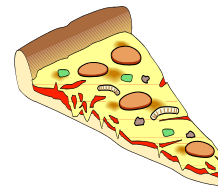
