Constantly sacrificing is to not quit when times become difficult and the work burdensome.

Constantly envisioning is to set our eyes on things above and not on things on earth and refusing to be ensnared by earthly success.

APPLICATION:

2. If we are to become the kind of disciples God wants us to be, let us be genuinely concerned of the welfare of the congregation.

• Willingness to feed the flock is the pure desire to feed them only with what is nurturing – that means we only teach the oracles of God, no more no less.

• Willingness to oversee the flock is the pure desire to keep an eye on the spiritual welfare of the congregation - so that no one will develop a sinful and an unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. Also, to guard them from wolves!

• Willingness to serve the flock is the pure desire to be like Jesus who came to serve and not to be served.

APPLICATION:

3. If we are to become the kind of disciples God wants us to be, let us be indisputably desirous of pleasing only the Lord.

Pleasing the Lord alone is for the reason that we love the Lord our God with all our heart, all our soul, all our mind, all our strength.

Pleasing the Lord alone is for the reason that He will come again as promised in indescribable glory.

Pleasing the Lord alone is for the reason that we are awatting for His approval when He shall say to the faithful: "Well done my good and faithful servant. Come and share your Master's happiness."
