# PRAISE FOR SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS IN CHRIST

Ephesians 1:1-3 Santiago B. Sameon II, BTh, Ed.D.

Ephesus was the Roman capital of the Roman Province of Asia. The epistle is captioned Ephesians as it is addressed to the church in Ephesus: 1:1, whose writer was apostle Paul, scripted at about A.D. 62, in Rome, which he established, towards the close of his second missionary journey, where he preached in a synagogue, prior his first imprisonment in Rome. He left behind him Priscilla and Aquila while he proceeded to Jerusalem (Acts 18: 19.21).

A. MAIN THEME OF PAUL'S LETTER TO THE EPHESIANS- The letter declares that the Christian mystery (gospel) of salvation, first revealed to the Apostles, is the source of true wisdom.

#### B. AUTHOR = PAUL

His Calling and Authority- "an apostle of Christ Jesus" Eph.1:1

#### C. RECIPIENTS (Eph.1:1)

- Their Calling -- "to the saints" called to be holy
- Place -- "who are at Ephesus"
- Their Submission -- "and who are faithful in Christ Jesus'

#### D. ALL CHRISTIANS ARE SAINTS

#### E. GREETING - Eph.1:2

- Grace is all God's power, all His love, all His beauty, available to mankind. Grace is charming, lovely, pleasant. It is something which pleases, which imparts charm and loveliness to a life.
- Peace is freedom from anxiety, fear and worry. A sense of security, of trust. According to Strong's concordance, it means completeness, soundness, and welfare. It comes from the root word shalam, which means making amends or making whole or complete.

#### F. GOD DESERVES OUR BLESSING

- Concept of Blessing -- "speak well of" or "eulogize"; used only in the NT of either God or Christ;
- One mark of our maturity is our devotion to God and how we express it. God deserves our blessing and praise. "Nothing is more appropriate for God's people than to bless Him for His great goodness. In all things -- whether pain, struggle, trials, frustration, opposition, or adversity -- we are to praise God, because He is good in the midst of it all. For that we praise and bless Him..." (MacArthur)

#### G. DESIGNATION OF GOD- "the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ" Eph.1:3

Paul points to our unity with Christ as he describes God in terms of relationships that can apply to both Christ and to us


