I. CHRIST EXALTED IN THE RESURRECTION

Ephesians 1:20

- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY RAISING HIM FROM THE DEAD
  - Proves that God has power over death.
  - Christ is not dead but is alive forevermore.
  - We exalt Christ with our new life.
- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY HAVING HIM SEATED AT HIS RIGHT HAND
  - Proves that God the Father honors Christ.
  - Christ is to be honored and magnified.
  - We exalt Christ by worshipping Him.
- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY HAVING HIM IN THE HEAVENLY REALMS
  - Proves that Christ ascended into Heaven.
  - Christ is reigning from Heaven.
  - We exalt Christ by focusing on our heavenly calling.

APPLICATION:

1. As the Heavenly Father exalted Christ with the resurrection, let us in turn exalt Him with our new life.

- Having proven that God has power over death, let us have the confidence that the same power that raised Christ raises us to eternal life and that this power should also be evident in our new life.
- Recognizing the preeminence of Christ, let us worship, serve, and love Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. Whatever we do, work at it with all our heart, as working for the Lord, not for men (Colossians 3:23).
- Realizing Christ's ascension to Heaven, let us focus on our heavenly calling.

II. CHRIST EXALTED WITH DOMINION OVER ALL

Ephesians 1:21

- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY GIVING HIM POWER AND DOMINION
  - Proves that Christ is one with the Father.
  - Christ is ruler over all created things.
  - We exalt Christ by following His rules.
- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY GIVING HIM DOMINION IN THE PRESENT AGE
  - Proves that Christ is reigning now.
  - Christ is ruling & His rule applies in our days.
  - We exalt Christ by being faithful disciples.
- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY GIVING HIM DOMINION IN THE AGE TO COME
  - Proves that Christ reigns forever.
  - Christ will exercise unending power.
  - We exalt Christ by anticipating His return.

APPLICATION:

2. As the Heavenly Father exalted Christ with dominion, let us in turn exalt Him with submission.

- Having proven that Christ reigns over all now and forever, let us be eager to surrender ourselves to Him as well as our will to His will, confident that He is in total control over all things.
- Recognizing the power and dominion of Christ in the present age, let us exercise the power given us as disciples for God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7)
- Realizing Christ's eternal supremacy, let us look forward to His return by being prepared for it every day.

III. CHRIST EXALTED AS THE HEAD OF THE CHURCH

Ephesians 1:22-23

- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY PUTTING ALL THINGS UNDER HIS FEET
  - Proves Christ's complete triumph.
  - Christ will subdue for us all our enemies.
  - We exalt Christ with every victory.
- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY MAKING HIM SUPREME HEAD OF THE CHURCH
  - Proves Christ's complete control.
  - Christ will direct us in all things.
  - We exalt Christ with our obedience.
- GOD EXALTED CHRIST BY MAKING HIM FILL EVERYTHING EVERYWHERE WITH HIMSELF
  - Proves Christ's complete sustaining power.
  - Christ will sustain all our needs.
  - We exalt Christ by depending on Him.

APPLICATION:

3. As the Heavenly Father exalted Christ as head of the church, let us in turn exalt Him with obedience.

- Having proven Christ's complete victory over the enemy with His obedience to the Father, let us also obey His commands, confident that we will never go wrong when we follow the Lord and His will.
- Recognizing Christ's headship over the church, let us conform our minds, hearts, and actions to that of our Lord Jesus Christ for everyone who is fully taught will be like his teacher (Luke 6:40).
- Realizing Christ's power to sustain us, let the church depend on Him in everything, confident that He will cause us to will and to act according to His purpose.

How can we, the church, exalt or praise Christ just as God the Father exalted Him?
