APPLICATION:

3. In what ways are we failing to become rich toward God?

When we fail to use what has been entrusted to us for the benefit of God's kingdom or the church? When we think that 'our goods' are but results of our ability? Thinking that 'our goods' is to be deservedly enjoyed by oneself and is not intended for the greater good of many? (1 Peter 4:10) When we use 'our time' for things of lesser value in the eyes of the Lord? (Col 4:5) When we can't take rejection or persecution for being a Christian? (Heb 10:32-34)

How can we avoid becoming like the rich fool?

Let us recognize the serious warning against covetousness or greed. Let's resist our human tendency to be discontented and to covet.

Let us recognize that earthly things are temporary and so is our life. Let's make use of whatever circumstances we find ourselves in order to honor God!

Let us recognize the opportunities for us to store up treasures in heaven. Let's put our blessings, time, talents, treasures, and our lives into good use for God's glory!

Remember your Creator in the days of your youth, before the days of trouble come and the years approach when you will say, "I find no pleasure in them..." Ecclesiastes 12:1
