On the day of judgment, many who today are first in the eyes of men will be last in God's eyes, and many who are last in the eyes of men will be first in the eyes of God (Luke 13:30). This is the true blessing.

Be inclined in laying up treasures in heaven (Matt 6:20) and becoming "rich toward God" (Luke 12:21).

• Let's take solemn warnings that we do not treat God's invitations or calls lightly (Isaiah 55:6, Prov 1:24-33).

• Let's not put our confidence on tomorrow (Prov 27:1).

• Let's keep thinking about our souls for what good is it if we have gained the whole world and yet forfeit our souls (Mark 8:36)? We also must make men think about their souls by sharing the gospel of salvation in Christ.
