


TEMPTATION ON THE SON OF MAN LUKE 4:1-13

SANTIAGO B. SAMEON II, EDD

Introduction: Luke 4:1-13, we find the devil doing these things with Jesus. Testing Jesus, Tempting Him during His forty days in the wilderness. The Devil is desperately seeking to stop Jesus from doing the work that our Heavenly Father commissioned Him to do.

These texts help us to deal with Temptation like what Jesus did. It will be very difficult for us, but we can learn how Jesus Triumphed over Temptations.

THE IMPORTANCE OF STUDYING TEMPTATION

1. To Become more like Jesus (2 Cor. 3:18)

- 2. To Become more Aware of Satan's Devices (2 Cor. 2:11)
- 3. To Become more Equipped Against Temptations (2 Tim. 3:16,17)
- 4. To give hope to others in their struggle against temptations (2 Tim. 2:26)

#1 WE MUST RELY ON THE SUPERIORITY OF THE SON OF GOD.

FIRST TEMPTATION: To turn Stone into bread-Lk.4:3;Matt.4:3(Lust of the flesh)

- Physical needs must not be priority in life (<u>Deut. 8:2,3</u>)
- Satan Offers a Shortcut (food without work)Gen. 3:17-19;Jas. 5:7
- Heb. 2:18 states, "Since He Himself was tempted in that He has suffered, He is able to help those ٠ who are tempted." Thus, we must rely on the superiority of the Son of God.

#2. WE MUST BE AWARE OF THE SCHEMES OF SATAN

SECOND TEMPTATION: Satan Showed All the Kingdoms-Lk.4:6-8 (Lust of the Eyes)

Deut.6:13. "Worship the Lord your God, and serve only him.". Our task is to worship, serve, trust, and love and leave the rest to God.

3. WE MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH GOD'S NOBLE METHODS FOR THE SAINTS

THIRD TEMPTATION: (Pride of Life) Satan uses scriptures-Ps.91

"For all that is in the world— the desires of the flesh, the desires of the eyes, and the pride of *life— is not from the Father but from the world."* (1 John 2:16)

FIVE STRATEGIES TO OVERCOME TEMPTATION

- 1. Time with God (Jn.5:7)
- 2. Be Ready to be Tempted, especially after success (Matt.26:41)"Watch and pray so you will not fall *into temptation"*)
- 3. Be Filled with the Holy Spirit (Lk.4:1)
- 4. Be armed with the Scripture (Eph.6:10-18"...put on the armor of God..."; 1 Peter 4:11-" If any man speaks let him speak as the oracle of God...")
- 5. Be Ready for Further Attacks (1 Pet.5:8)"...your enemy the Devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour"

Conclusion: We learned from our lesson the following:

- 1. Importance of Studying Temptation.
- 2. We must Rely on the Superiority of the Son of God.
- 3. We must Be Aware of the Schemes of Satan.
- 4. We must Be Equipped with God's Noble Methods for the Saints.


