• "May grace and peace be multiplied to you in [the full personal, precise, and correct] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. (2 Peter 1:2 AMP)

3. As Christian stewards, how can we better exercise accountability?

• We must work on our fear of the Lord so much so as to courageously welcome every work the Lord God Almighty has prepared for us to do.

• We must nurture in us the love for the Lord so much so as to cheerfully fulfill one's duttes.

• We must cultivate in us the love of the Lord's warnings so much so as to resist temptations to be lazy about our discipleship.

• "So we make it our goal to please him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it. 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad. "2 Cor 5:9-10
