

## **BEWARE OF CARELESSNESS**

LUKE 12:35-53 SANTIAGO B. SAMEON II. ED.D.

CARELESSNESS (Luke 12:35-48) is connected with covetousness, for he who is absorbed in the things of earth is not getting prepared for those of heaven. It must be noted that He comes before daybreak (Luke 12:38) thus, the need to watch.

On the topic of readiness and accountability Jesus Has much to say related to His Second Coming. Religious leaders miserably failed in distinguishing when Jesus was with them in His three-year ministry on earth, likely they will miss out on His Second Coming! Jesus wants His disciples to focus on eternal value rather than temporary worldly pursuits like the Gentiles. They need to take their stewardship seriously and perform the will of their Master even though His return date is uncertain.

#### I. WATCH AND WAIT (LK.12:35-40)

To be ready for the Lord's return, we must be like servants who are dressed and ready for action, with lamps burning. This means we should live a life of readiness and anticipation, being spiritually prepared at all times. Being prepared involves staying close to the Lord through prayer, studying His Word, and being mindful of our actions and behavior. Weariness of waiting for the return of Jesus on account of uncertainty. Jesus delays His coming to save more people from judgment in the last days. >Servants Be Readv

We should be like those servants who eagerly waited for their master to come to the wedding feast. Joyful expectation for the Lord's return, when we will be united with Him in the heavenly glory. This anticipation should cause us to live our lives with hope and confidence in the promises of God by setting our focus on things above (Col.3:2). >Christ's Coming is Unknown

Luke 12:35-38 urge us to prioritize spiritual preparedness, remain vigilant in our faith, and actively serve others. Let us set our lives on how we can be more prepared for Christ's return and shine brightly as beacons of His love in a world in need of hope. We heed the call to stay active in faith, serve others selflessly, and keep the light of Christ burning brightly in all things we do.Paul says in whatever you do, Col.3:17,do it all for the glory of God. Be prepared to give a testimony of your faith, or respond with the word of God, in season and out of season (2 Tim.4:2). Wait patiently for the Lord's coming!

### II. WORK PATIENTLY FOR THE LORD'S COMING! (Lk.41-48)

Jesus message for His disciples and elders who were going to be given the charge to shepherd the flock of God. And that message was - I want you to be ready, feed My sheep; make sure they get the pure milk of the Word; that they are fed with the rich meat of the Word of God; protect them from wolves; shepherd their souls; while the world is caring about what they can get out of those sheep, you be concerned to serve and help those sheep, building them up and encourage them in their time of need. That's what Jesus was saving to the disciples, to the elders, but He was also speaking for us all. And the "for us all" is this - "to whom much is given, much is required." The judgment of leaders will be correspondingly heavy, since more is required of them because of their privileged position (Lk.12: 47.48: James 3:1).

### >Doing! (Lk.12:43)

The master instructs His servants to patiently do their work while waiting for their master's coming. Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, much is expected of him.

#### >The Master Does Not Excuse Ignorance

Ignorance of the Divine shall not wholly excuse the sinner, he shall be beaten, but his stripes shall be few, his damnation shall be gentle compared with a minister's, that knows his Master's will but does not teach others....God looks upon the illbehaved ministers as the greatest transgressors. Acts 17:30-21-27

The master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him: Ready or not, one day the master will come. When He comes. He will punish those who were not ready and will reward the ready.

CONCLUSION: Luke 12:51-53 emphasize the importance of being prepared by: I. WATCHING AND WAITING (LK.12:35-40) II. WORKING PATIENTLY FOR THE LORD'S COMING! (Lk.41-48)
