PREPARING FOR THE PASSOVER

I. THE PLAN TO KILL JESUS (MATT.26:4, MK.14:1, LK.22:2)

Luke 22:1,2 tells us that it is the Passover week. The religious leaders are still looking for a way to kill Jesus. The leaders did their best to entrap Jesus in chapter 20: (1) That He would make a treasonous talk against Rome and thus handed Him over to them for judgment or, (2)He would make an unpopular talk that would cause Jewish authorities to arrest him. The Jewish leaders however have failed in both schemes and thus further looked for a way to execute Him.

II. DISLOYALTY OF JUDAS ISCARIOT (LK. 22:2-6)

Luke 22:3 tells us that Satan entered the heart of apostle Judas, to betray Jesus. John 13:2 records that the devil put into Judas' heart to betray Jesus.

The Jewish leaders fear the crowds and cannot go into the temple to arrest him. Luke 21:37 tells us that Jesus will not stay in a house that night where they could find him. Jesus went back to the Mount of Olives where He stayed in the Kidron Valley in the Mount of Olives. The Jewish leaders and authorities did not know where He slept. Judas agreed to betray Jesus where crowds were present (Lk. 22:6). Thirty (30) pieces of silver was the agreed pay for the betrayal.

III. FORMULATION FOR THE PASSOVER (LK.22:7-13)
It is the day on which the Passover lamb must be sacrificed so people may be redeemed. Jesus tells Peter and John to make preparations for the Passover. A time when every Jew was required to come to Jerusalem. The Law required a room where the family would eat the Passover meal and keep the regulations of the Law. Everything is planned by God and the Lord is in control of events.

Jesus shows the predetermined plan of God. Jesus knows what is going to happen and wanted to share this Passover with his disciples. Jesus knows about his death and will not eat this Passover with them again in the flesh. The true Lamb of salvation is about to be slain. Where this Passover word commences.

The Passover was celebrated on the 14th and 15th of the month Nisan (roughly March—April). On the afternoon of the 14th, the Passover lambs were slaughtered at the temple. The new Jewish day began at sunset, the evening of that same day was the beginning of the 15th, and the actual meal was held then. The days of Unleavened Bread lasted from the 15th to the 21st of the month. In Lk.22:7 the 14th is described as the day of Unleavened Bread because the feasts were closely linked, for non-Jewish readers who used a calendar with the day starting at midnight. [Marshall, I. H. (1994).

Passover, Pesach in Hebrew, commemorates the Israelites' deliverance from slavery in Egypt. The preparation for Passover is significant in Jewish tradition. God commanded Moses and Aaron regarding the observance of the Passover, on the importance of preparation. The preparation begins on the 10th day of the first month, Nisan, when each household is to select a lamb without blemish (Exodus 12:3-5). In the New Testament, Passover foreshadows the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ. The Last Supper, which Jesus shared with His disciples, was a Passover meal (Matt. 26:17-19). Jesus' crucifixion during Passover week highlights the fulfillment of the Passover lamb's symbolism, as His blood brings redemption. Passover preparation, therefore, is not only historical and cultural practice but also a profound spiritual exercise that points to the redemptive work of Jesus Christ. ercise that points to the redemptive work of Jesus Christ.

CONCLUSION

The meal we partake is a memorial of Jesus Christ. Great events deserve great memorials. Jesus' disciples ate the Passover meal but Jesus took it as a meaningful moment and applied it to himself. He is our Passover and our deliverer. It is his blood that causes God's wrath to pass over us. We do not get what we deserve because Jesus gave His life for us. Christ is our Passover (1 Cor. 5:7). Let us live in the knowledge that we have been redeemed and owe to Jesus everything. Above all let us remember that every Sunday is a celebration of our redemption as we remember the memorial! Ω


