THE BURNING HEART: EXPERIENCING THE RISEN CHRIST

Luke 23:39-56

- THE TWO DISCIPLES RECOGNIZED THE RESURRECTED CHRIST
 - Luke 24:28-32
- THE TWO DISCIPLES SHARED THEIR EXPERIENCE REGARDING THE RISEN CHRIST
 - Luke 24:33-35
- THE DISCIPLES WERE CONVINCED ABOUT THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST
 - Luke 24:36-43

I. THE TWO DISCIPLES RECOGNIZED THE RISEN CHRIST

Luke 24:28-32

- BURNING HEARTS MADE THE DISCIPLES INVITE THE LORD JESUS
 - "But they urged him strongly, 'Stay with us...'"
 - The disciples are naturally drawn to the Lord Jesus.
- BURNING HEARTS LED THE DISCIPLES TO RECOGNIZE THE LORD JESUS
 - "Their eyes were opened and they recognized him."
 - The disciples are adept in recognizing the Lord.
- BURNING HEARTS COME WITH AN UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURES
 - "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"
 - The disciples are awakened to the truth of God's Word and is filled with a passionate desire for Him.

APPLICATION:

1. Are we disciples with 'burning hearts' or with deep conviction who readily recognize the lordship of Jesus?
 - Are we developing a welcoming spirit to the Lord's leading and to His thoughts and His ways?
 - Are we developing a keen discernment of the Lord's perspective making us recognize what is by the Lord, of the Lord, in the Lord, and for the Lord?
 - Are we marked by a deep hunger for His Word, a fervent desire for prayer, an unquenchable thirst for righteousness, and one yearning to glorify Christ and not one's self?
 - "My soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, like a weary land where there is no water. So I have looked for you in the sanctuary, to see your power and your glory." (Ps 63:1-2)

II. THE TWO DISCIPLES SHARED THEIR EXPERIENCE REGARDING THE RISEN CHRIST

Luke 24:33-35

- BURNING HEARTS MADE THE DISCIPLES BELIEVE, REPENT, AND TAKE ACTION
 - "They got up and returned at once to Jerusalem."
 - The disciples realized something urgent - providing crucial evidence to other disciples who had not yet seen Jesus themselves.
- BURNING HEARTS MADE THE DISCIPLES CONFIRM & TESTIFY ABOUT THE TRUTH
 - "saying, 'It is true! The Lord has risen...'"
 - The disciples talked about something all-important - the truth that Jesus has risen.
- BURNING HEARTS MADE THE DISCIPLES TALK ABOUT THEIR EXPERIENCE
 - "Then the two told what had happened..."
 - The disciples recounted when they recognized the Lord Jesus - when Jesus broke the bread.

APPLICATION:

2. Are we disciples with 'burning hearts' who zealously share our experience about the Lord Jesus?
 - When in recognizing the urgency of helping others to believe and not doubt the claims of Christ, are we apt to provide crucial evidence from the Word?
 - When in standing for truth and in contending for the faith in the Savior Jesus and in His redemptive work, do we emphasize the victory of Jesus?
 - When in partaking of the Communion or the Lord's Supper, do we realize our sins, faults, shortcomings, and flaws...and do we repent...and take action?
 - "That is why the Lord says, 'Turn to me now, while there is time. Give me all your hearts. Come with fasting, weeping, mourning, 13 Let your remorse tear at your hearts and not your garments.'" Joel 2:12-13 TLB

III. THE TWO DISCIPLES WERE CONVINCED ABOUT THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST

Luke 24:36-43

- SLOW OF HEART BRINGS ABOUT FEAR
 - "Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you.'"
 - All the other disciples heard from Jesus a most assuring greeting but remained terrified.
- SLOW OF HEART BRINGS ABOUT DOUBT
 - "Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see."
 - All the other disciples saw with their own eyes the evidence of the risen Jesus but doubted.
- SLOW OF HEART MAKES LACK OF EVIDENCE
 - "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate it in their presence."
 - All the other disciples were given every evidence to be convinced of the Lord's resurrection.

APPLICATION:

3. How do we know we are disciples who are 'slow of heart' and are losing a 'burning heart'?
 - When, despite the promises of the Lord, do we remain fearful or anxious to take steps in obeying the Lord and His commands, instructions, and guidance?
 - When, despite the evidences, do we remain skeptical or in doubt about matters of faith and our thoughts consumed by the daily grind, insecurities, and fears, rather than by focusing on Jesus?
 - When we think, work, and act, do we rely or trust on physical evidence or circumstances, human understanding, connections, or what our senses tell us rather than in God and in His word and promises?
 - Are we walking by sight and not by faith?
 - "For we live by faith and not by sight." 2 Corinthians 5:7

" Sometimes I think, "I will make no mention of his message. I will not speak as his messenger any more." But then his message becomes like a fire locked up inside of me, burning in my heart and soul. I grow weary of trying to hold it in; I cannot contain it.

Jeremiah 20:9 NET

How and when do we experience the risen Christ?

1. When we readily recognize the lordship of Christ and develop a welcoming spirit to the Lord's leading and to His thoughts and His ways making us recognize what is by the Lord, of the Lord, in the Lord, and for the Lord. The challenge is - who controls me? Myself or God?
2. When we zealously share the Gospel of Christ knowing it is the power unto salvation that makes us realize our sins, our faults, our shortcomings, and our flaws, and thereby repent and take action. The challenge is - are we so convinced of this that we share the Gospel?
3. When we confidently act according to faith such that our work is produced by faith, our labor prompted by love, and our endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. The challenge is - will we live by sight or by faith?

Remember your Creator in the days of your youth, before the days of trouble come and the years approach when you will say, "I find no pleasure in them..." Ecclesiastes 12:1
