#### I. TRAINED TO LOVE AND TO BE SUBJECT TO THEIR HUSBANDS

Titus 2:4,5

- ACCEPT THE BIBLICAL TEACHING OF THE DESIGN OF MARRIAGE
  - Wives make men husbands.
  - Marriage emphasizes unconditional love.
- ACCEPT THE BIBLICAL TEACHING OF THE WIFE'S ROLE
  - Wives make the suitable mate for the man.
  - Marriage appropriately meets the human need for companionship.
- ACCEPT THE BIBLICAL TEACHING OF BEING A SUBMISSIVE WIFE
  - Wives are called to submit to, and to respect their husbands' leadership "as to the Lord".
  - Marriage reflects the relationship of Christ and His church.

#### APPLICATION:

- In what ways can younger women, as disciples of Jesus Christ, promote God's design for marriage?
  - Promote selfless love when your spouse is struggling to be "lovable," by responding with patience and support rather than distance or criticism.
  - Promote companionship by spending dedicated, quality time together, reinforcing that your bond is a priority over work, hobbies, or digital distractions.
  - Promote supportive partnership by acting as a "helper" who supports the husband's decision-making rather than fostering independence or competition.
  - "Love bears up under anything and everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything. Love never fails [never fades out]. 1 Cor 13:7-8 AMP

#### APPLICATION:

- In what ways can younger women, as disciples of Jesus Christ, promote God's design for family life?
  - Promote parenthood as a normative activity within the framework of marriage as designed by the Sovereign Creator in order to uphold sanctity of life, the stability of society, and the intentional nurturing of the next generation in faith and virtue.
  - Promote raising godly children as a high-calling where parents invest love, discipline, and intentional spiritual training to raise them for God's glory.
  - Promote domestic roles as normative for women since they are naturally inclined toward nurturing, making them uniquely suited for homemaking and raising children.
  - "A wise woman builds her home, but a foolish woman tears it down with her own hands." Proverbs 14:1 NLT

#### APPLICATION:

- In what ways can younger women, as disciples of Jesus Christ, promote God's desired virtues for them?
  - Promote the understanding that modesty extends beyond clothing to a humble heart that seeks to honor God rather than bringing attention to oneself.
  - Promote fidelity in marriage which means a strict faithfulness to one's spouse, both physically and emotionally to "keep the marriage bed undefiled."
  - Promote a good-natured character by speaking with wisdom, ensuring that "the teaching of kindness is on her tongue." Her words are used to encourage, or heal, to build up, and not to destroy.
  - "She speaks with wisdom, and faithful instruction is on her tongue. She watches over the affairs of her household and does not eat the bread of idleness. Prov 31:26-27 NIV

#### III. TRAINED TO PRACTICE SELF-CONTROL, PURITY, AND KINDNESS

Titus 2:5

- ACCEPT THE BIBLICAL TEACHING TO PRACTICE SELF-CONTROL
  - Wives, like everyone else should be, must be virtuous and discreet, not foolish or unwise.
  - Promotes respectful and ethical behavior.
- ACCEPT THE BIBLICAL TEACHING TO PRACTICE PURITY
  - Wives, like everyone else should be, must be chaste, and not to be lewd or promiscuous.
  - Promotes trust, respect, stability in marriage.
- ACCEPT THE BIBLICAL TEACHING TO PRACTICE KINDNESS
  - Wives, like everyone should be, must be good-natured or kindhearted, not mean.
  - Promotes an environment ideal for growth and success in all relationships.




