GRACES OF THE HEIRS OF GRACE

Titus 3:1-2

- BEING MINDFUL OF OUR DUTY TO AUTHORITY
 - A call to respect and to cooperate with governing structures. Titus 3:1a
- BEING MINDFUL OF OUR DEDICATION TO GOOD WORKS
 - A shift from passive compliance to active service in the community. Titus 3:1b
- BEING MINDFUL OF OUR ATTITUDE TOWARDS ALL PEOPLE
 - A transformation of the tongue and the heart to reflect Christ-like character. Titus 3:2

I. BEING MINDFUL OF OUR DUTY TO AUTHORITY

Titus 3:1a

- MINDFUL TO REMIND OTHERS OF THEIR DUTIES
 - Encourage gentle correction and warning, mutual accountability, and building one another up.
 - Promotes a great sense of community.
- MINDFUL TO SUBMIT TO GOVERNING AUTHORITIES
 - Encourage an attitude of placing oneself under someone else out of respect and humility.
 - Promotes harmony, peace, and order.
- MINDFUL TO BE OBEDIENT TO GOVERNING AUTHORITIES
 - Encourage following instructions readily.
 - Promotes citizens to lead quiet and productive lives.

APPLICATION:

1. In what ways can we respond to the call to respect and to cooperate with governing structures?
 - Fulfilling Basic Civic Duties, Obeying local ordinances and national laws ensures societal order and demonstrates respect for the rule of law.
 - Active and Constructive Participation. Utilizing the right to vote, attending local community meetings, and joining public forums help voice community concerns.
 - Promoting Accountability and Good Governance. Providing constructive feedback for actionable, solution-oriented feedback to leaders rather than resorting to insults or unconstructive criticism.
 - Romans 13:1 "Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established."

II. BEING MINDFUL OF OUR DEDICATION TO GOOD WORKS

Titus 3:1b

- MINDFUL TO BE PREPARED TO DO GOOD WORKS
 - Encourage living with intentional, daily readiness to serve others and to honor God.
 - Promotes a life of purpose.
- MINDFUL TO BE WILLING TO DO GOOD WORKS
 - Encourage an attitude of doing things out of a sincere desire to serve others.
 - Promotes consistent moral uprightness and community welfare over personal gain.
- MINDFUL TO BE ZEALOUS IN DOING GOOD WORKS
 - Encourage to pursue acts of kindness, service, and righteousness with wholehearted enthusiasm.
 - Promotes a lifestyle that rejects lawless behavior in favor of reflecting the character of God.

APPLICATION:

2. In what ways can we shift from passive compliance to active service in the community?
 - Start with Mindset Transformation. Our goal should not simply not to break rules but to take the initiative to solve problems and to address needs.
 - Shift focus. Before engaging in a task, ask oneself, "How will this make someone's life better today?" instead of "What can I gain from this?"
 - Shift to Actionable Service. Let's not wait for the opportunity. Let's look for ways to be generous, hospitable, and kind in the spaces we already inhabit — our home, our workplace, our school, our club, team, group, or our neighborhood.
 - Romans 12:11 "Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord."

III. BEING MINDFUL OF OUR ATTITUDE TOWARDS ALL PEOPLE

Titus 3:2

- MINDFUL TO NOT SLANDER ANYONE
 - Encourage guarding one's tongue and using speech that edify others.
 - Promotes stronger relationships, fosters trust, and creates a supportive environment.
- MINDFUL TO BE PEACEABLE AND CONSIDERATE
 - Encourage a forbearing attitude- yielding, gentle, and conciliatory.
 - Promotes harmony, diffuses tension, turns away wrath and prevents escalation of conflicts.
- MINDFUL TO SHOW TRUE HUMILITY TOWARD ALL MEN
 - Encourage unqualified courtesy.
 - Promotes a grounding principle that can transform relationships and daily interactions.

APPLICATION:

3. In what ways can we realize a transformation of the tongue and the heart to reflect Christ-like character?
 - Practice the T.H.I.N.K. First Rule. Before we speak, let's pause if what we are about to say is True, Helpful, Inspiring, Necessary, and Kind.
 - Give Others the Benefit of the Doubt. If someone is difficult or short-tempered, remember they may be dealing with personal stress, making it easier to offer grace.
 - Choose Empathy Over Arguments: Ask oneself, "Is being 'right' at the moment more important than the relationship?" Often, letting go of minor grievances preserves harmony and builds long-term goodwill.
 - Ephesians 4:29 "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."

"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus...

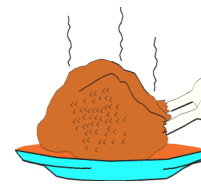
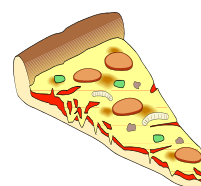
What graces should Christians remember as heirs of God's grace?
